GOSPEL REFLECTION Lk 16:19-31

"Lazarus was carried by the angels to Abraham's bosom"

What most absorbs your time, your attention, and your heart? In the parable of Lazarus and the rich man Jesus paints a dramatic scene of contrasts -- riches and poverty, heaven and hell, compassion and indifference, inclusion and exclusion. We also see an abrupt and dramatic reversal of fortune. Lazarus was not only poor, but incapacitated. He was "laid" at the gates of the rich man's house. The dogs which licked his sores probably also stole the little bread he procured for himself. Dogs in the ancient world symbolized contempt. Enduring the torment of these savage dogs only added to the poor man's miseries and sufferings. The rich man treated the beggar with contempt and indifference, until he found his fortunes reversed! The name *Lazarus* means *God is my help*. Despite a life of misfortune and suffering, Lazarus did not lose hope in God. His eyes were set on a treasure stored up for him in heaven. The rich man, however, could not see beyond his material treasure. He not only had every thing he needed, he indulged in his wealth to excess. He was too absorbed in what he had to notice the needs of those around him. He lost sight of God and the treasure of heaven because he was preoccupied with seeking happiness in material things. He served wealth rather than God. In the end the rich man became a beggar! Do you know the joy and freedom of possessing God as your only treasure? And is your hope securely anchored in heaven?

EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY: IHM Lubov Nursery School has an opening for an ECE II or experienced CCA. The position is part-time, 3 days per week, 7 hours per day with 3 hours extra per week for planning time. Our program runs from September until the end of May. We are looking for a strong staff who will work closely with the Director to develop and implement an enhanced program that will build on children’s interests and needs and will support and promote the physical, cognitive, social and emotional development of all children. Our “learning through play” program provides a Ukrainian Catholic, Christian environment and includes an introduction to the Ukrainian language and culture. Having experience and knowledge of the Ukrainian language would be an asset. It is inclusive of all children of any ability and welcomes families of any faith or culture. A clear criminal reference check and child abuse registry (within the last 3 months) and CPR and First Aid certificate is required or be willing to acquire. We have the following church protocols for in-person attendance at any given time that includes:

- A MAXIMUM 1/3 occupancy capacity.
- Sanitization stations.
- Health survey and contacts recorded upon entry.
- Usher led Social distancing.
- Sanitization of all areas after use. (Electrostatic sprayer - which delivers the most enhanced method of sanitization)
- Masks are mandatory, clergy included.
- Clergy taking all measures to glove and use disposable utensils for distribution of communion.
- Liturgy is cantor led. (no other singing / silent prayer by congregation)
