FAMILY BLESSING OF THE HOME

We gather together as a family to bless the home with Jordan Blessed Holy Water. We light at least one candle. It is customary for the youngest or the oldest to hold the candle, although all can have candles as a symbol of the Light of Christ that dispels the darkness from our home. One member of the family takes the role of leader and the rest respond.

Leader: Through the prayers of our holy fathers, O Lord Jesus Christ, our God, have mercy on us.

Response: Amen.

Heavenly King, Comforter, Spirit of Truth, You are everywhere present and fill all things. Treasury of Blessings and Giver of Life, come and dwell within us, cleanse us of all stain, and save our souls, O gracious Lord.

Holy God, Holy and Mighty, Holy and Immortal, have mercy on us. (3 times)

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and forever and ever. Amen.

O Most Holy Trinity, have mercy on us; O Lord, cleanse us of our sins; O Master, forgive our transgressions; O Holy One, come to us and heal our infirmities for Your name's sake.

Immediately on coming out of the water he saw the sky rent in two and the Spirit descending on him like a dove. Then a voice came from the heavens: "You are my beloved Son. On you my favour rests."

Response: Glory be to You, O Lord, glory be to You.

Leader: Let us pray to the Lord.

Response: Lord, have mercy.

Leader: O God, our Savior, you entered the home of Zacchaeus and brought salvation to him and to all those who lived there. In the same way, O Lord, enter into our home, and keep all of us who live here safe from all harm. We ask You: bless this home through the sprinkling of this water, sanctified in remembrance of your baptism in the River Jordan. Keep it safe and sound, a peaceful haven against the winds of adversity, a place of love and security for all of us who live here. Bless and protect each of us, and give to each constantly and abundantly of your goodness; health, hope, and happiness, courage and confidence, an awareness and assurance of your lasting love and presence.
