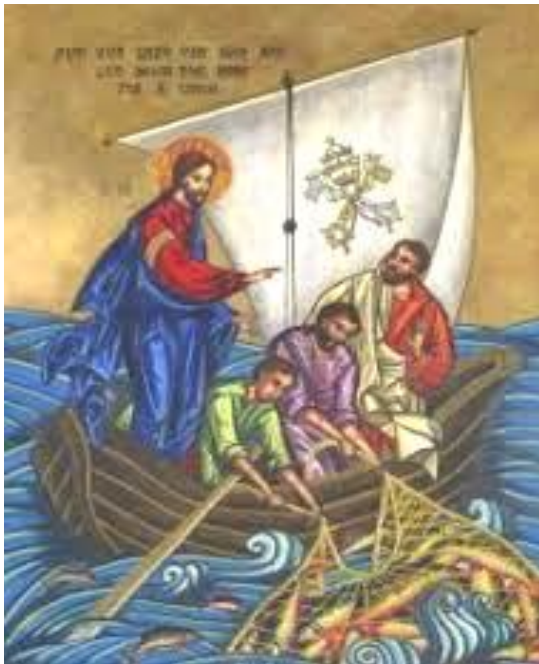

GOSPEL REFLECTION: Matthew 4: 18-23

As Jesus was walking by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon who is called Peter, and his brother Andrew, casting a net into the sea; they were fishermen. He said to them, "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." [Matthew 4:18-19](#)



Andrew and his brother Peter were fishermen who would soon take on a new form of fishing. They would soon become "fishers of men," as Jesus said. But prior to being sent on this mission by our Lord, they had to become His followers. And this happened as our Lord was first the fisher of these men.

Notice that in this Gospel, Jesus was simply walking by and "saw" these two brothers working hard at their occupation. First, Jesus "saw" them, and then He called them. This gaze of our Lord is worth pondering.

Imagine the profound truth that our Lord is continually gazing at you with divine love, looking for the moment that you turn your attention to Him. His gaze is perpetual and deep. His gaze is one that yearns for you to follow Him, to abandon all else so as to hear His gentle invitation not only to follow Him but to then go forth and invite others on the journey of faith.

We, too, must allow the call of Andrew and Peter to also become our own calling. We must allow ourselves to notice Jesus as He looks at us, sees who we are, is aware of everything about us, and then speaks a word of invitation. He says to you, "Come after me..." This is an invitation that must permeate every aspect of your life. To "come after" Jesus is to leave all else behind and to make the act of following our Lord the single purpose of your life.

Sadly, many people pay little attention to this calling in their lives. Few people hear Him speak and fewer respond, and even fewer respond with complete abandonment of their lives.

Reflect, today, upon Jesus speaking these words to you. First, ponder the question of whether you have said "Yes" to Him with all the powers of your soul. Second, reflect upon those whom our Lord wants you to invite on the journey. To whom is Jesus sending you to invite? Who, in your life, is open to His call? Who does Jesus want to draw to Himself through you? Imitate these Apostles as they said "Yes" to our Lord, even though they did not immediately understand all that this would entail. Say "Yes" today and be ready and willing to do whatever comes next on this glorious journey of faith.

A Peace Summit is planned to take place on June 15-16, 2024, in Switzerland, where over 80 world leaders will gather to work on peace initiatives in order to stop the war.

Texts of President Zelensky's Appeal (English)

For them, it is a pleasure to burn.

We all know who we are dealing with. Russia is run by men who want to make it a norm – burning lives, destroying cities and villages, dividing people and erasing national borders through war. There is no nation that can stop such war alone, unaided – world leaders' engagement is needed.

I am now in Kharkiv – a city in the east of Ukraine and, unfortunately, very close to the border of Russia. What does it mean for Kharkiv? A third year of constant terror. More than a million of people in this city. And every night and every day the Russian army is shelling the city. Mostly with S-300 missiles. These are air defense missiles that Russia employs to terrorize the land. There is not a single district or street in Kharkiv that hasn't suffered from this regular cruelty. Russia added strikes with guided aerial bombs. Russian aviation comes close to our state border and launches these bombs straight on the city – it is a weapon of indiscriminate destruction. And anyone in any city of the world – from São Paulo to Harbin takes this the same way – as terror. Just like all other Russian strikes on hundreds of other of our cities and villages. Some of them, once booming with life, are now burnt to ashes, peopleless. A burnt-out emptiness is the most horrible consequence of war... A war that we didn't want in Ukraine, that we haven't provoked, and in which Ukraine is defending itself from Russian attempts to seize our resources and territories and destroy our national identity. And the world sees it.

Behind me are the books burnt down by Russian missiles. It was one of the largest publishing houses in Ukraine.

People got injured here. Unfortunately, there are people killed.

The temperature of burning here hasn't managed to totally reach four-hundred-fifty-one degrees Fahrenheit. But that's what the leaders of Russia need and want – even higher temperatures. And not only on the sovereign territory of Ukraine. Russia is threatening almost all of its neighboring countries. Russia is the only state that captured the nuclear power plant and is openly using it for radiation blackmail. There is nothing that wouldn't become a weapon for Russia including hunger, and exactly this the world felt when Ukraine was hit by a Russian naval blockade. Russia is the only source of aggression and constantly tries to expand the war. Right now, these days, we are defending ourselves 60 kilometers northeast from this place from yet another attempt of the Russian assault. Russia is preparing for offensive actions also 90 kilometers northwest from here – they gather another group of troops near our border... The one who does all this doesn't want peace.

Does Russia want a dialogue? Ukraine has the world's largest experience of lies from Russia during negotiations... Lies that in particular were Russian cover-ups for preparing this war. And that's exactly why global efforts are needed – the Global Peace Summit of the leaders whom Russia won't be able to deceive. Summit that will show who in the world really wants to end the war and not just claim the ceasefire which will inevitably be broken by Russian rockets and artillery just like it was dozens, dozens of times before...

Together with Switzerland, we are preparing such a Summit. It starts on June fifteenth.

Texts of President Zelensky's Appeal (Ukrainian)

Для них це задоволення – спалювати.

Ми всі знаємо, із ким маємо справу. Росією керують люди, які хочуть зробити нормою спалювати життя, руйнувати міста й села, розділяти народи та стирати національні кордони війною.

Немає нації, яка здатна зупинити таку війну лише своїми зусиллями. Потрібна участь лідерів світу.

Я зараз у Харкові. Це місто на сході України і, на жаль, дуже близько до кордону Росії. Що це означає для Харкова? Третій рік постійного терору. Більш як мільйон людей у цьому місті. І щочас, щодня російська армія обстрілює місто. Найбільше – ракетами С-300. Це ракети для протиповітряної оборони, які використовуються Росією для терору на землі. Немає зараз у Харкові жодного району міста та жодної вулиці, які не постраждали б від цього постійного знущання. Тепер Росія додала удари керованими авіабомбами. Російська авіація наближається до кордону нашої держави й запускає ці бомби просто по місту. Це зброя невибіркового ураження. І будь-яка людина в будь-якому місті світу – від Сан-Паулу до Харбіна – сприймає це однаково – як терор. Як і подібні ж удари Росії по сотнях інших наших міст і сіл. Деякі з них, де колись вирувало життя, зараз спалені просто в попіл, там не залишилося жодного мешканця. Випалена пустота – найжахливіший наслідок війни. Війни, якої ми в Україні не хотіли. Яку ми не провокували. І в якій Україна захищається від намагання Росії захопити наші ресурси й території та знищити нашу національну ідентичність. І світ це бачить.

За мною – книжки, спалені ударом російських ракет. Це було одне з найбільших видавництв України. Люди тут були поранені. На жаль, є загиблі. Температура горіння тут не встигла остаточно досягти 451 градуса за Фаренгейтом. Але саме цього прагнуть і хочуть лідери Росії – іще вищих температур. І не лише на суверенній території України. Росія погрожує майже всім своїм державам-сусідам. Росія – єдина держава, яка захопила атомну станцію та відверто використовує її для радіаційного шантажу. Немає нічого, що не стало б для Росії зброєю, – включно з голодом, і саме це відчув світ, коли Україна зазнала від Росії удару морської блокади. Саме Росія є єдиним джерелом агресії і постійно намагається розширити війну. Буквально зараз, цими днями, ми захищаємось за 60 кілометрів на північний

схід від цього місця від чергової спроби російського наступу. Росія готується до спроби наступальних дій і за 90 кілометрів звідси на північний захід – біля нашого кордону збирається ще одне угруповання військ. Той, хто все це робить, не хоче миру.

Чи хоче Росія діалогу? Україна має найбільший у світі досвід обману з боку Росії на перемовинах. Обману, який, зокрема, був прикриттям Росії для підготовки цієї війни. І саме тому потрібні глобальні зусилля – Саміт миру за участю лідерів, яких Росії не обманути. Саміт, який покаже, хто у світі дійсно хоче завершити війну, а не просто заявити про припинення вогню, яке буде неодмінно порушене російськими ракетами та артилерією, як це вже відбувалося десятки, десятки разів до цього.

Разом зі Швейцарією ми готуємо такий Саміт. 15 червня його початок.

Понад вісімдесят країн підтвердили свою участь. І ми продовжуємо працювати з лідерами, запрошуючи на Саміт. Дякую кожному, хто дійсно допомагає наблизити цей мир. Я звертаюся до лідерів світу, які поки осторонь глобальних зусиль із підготовки Саміту миру. До Президента Байдена, лідера Сполучених Штатів. До Президента Сі, лідера Китаю. Ми не хочемо, щоб Статут ООН згорів – згорів так само, як і ці книжки. І сподіваюся, не хочете й ви. Будь ласка, проявіть ваше лідерство у наближенні миру – дійсно миру, а не паузи між ударами. Зусилля світової більшості – це найкраща гарантія виконання зобов'язань. Будь ласка, підтримайте Саміт миру своїм персональним лідерством та участю.

What is God's call on your life? When Jesus chose His first disciples, He called ordinary people. Peter and Andrew were brothers and fishermen by trade. Like the other apostles they were non-professionals who had no wealth or position. In choosing ordinary people Jesus made extraordinary claims -- to leave all -- family, kin, and occupation--for the kingdom of God. When the Lord calls each of us to follow Him, He makes the same claim -- let nothing stand between you and Jesus. He chose these men, not for what they were, but for what they would be capable of becoming under His direction and power. When the Lord calls us to serve, we must not shrug back because we think that we have little or nothing to offer. The Lord takes what ordinary people, like us, can offer and uses it for greatness in His kingdom. Do you make your life an offering to the Lord and allow Him to use you as He sees fit?
